WHAT IS SEX TRAFFICKING

Sex trafficking is the use of force, fraud, or coercion to obtain some type of commercial sex act in exchange for something of value.

Minors under the age of 18 engaging in commercial sex are considered to be victims of human trafficking, and they don't have to prove the use of force, fraud, or coercion.

Children Can Be Sexually Exploited In Different Ways: Prostitution, Pornography, And/or Erotic Entertainment.
